Volunteer Commitment

Each GFA family is required to contribute **20 hours of volunteer service** during the school year. Parents who do not fulfill this requirement will be assessed a **\$400 Parent Involvement Fee**. Volunteer hours may be served in a variety of roles and school events. Grandparents, aunts, and uncles are able to volunteer to fulfill the 20 hours.
